

Operation of the County Card

The County Card Holder

KGU County Card holders should:

- Activate their card either online at **www.kentgolf.org** or by returning the form on the reverse of the letter attached to the County Card
- When seeking to use the County Card either at a Kent Club which is part of the scheme or a reciprocal club in another county (details of which are available on the Kent Golf Union website), a County Card holder must:
 - Make arrangements with the host club not less than 48 hours in advance of the proposed date and time of play;
 - Unless specifically arranged and agreed by the host club, not be part of a group of more than 4 persons;
 - Ensure that they have an up to date CONGU Handicap Certificate, if required by the host club;
 - On arrival at the host club, provide sight of their County Card together with proof of identity, such as a Driving Licence or Credit/Debit Card;
 - Only use the County Card once at any club in any County card year.

KGU County Card holders should be aware that Affiliated Clubs are not obliged to provide discounted green fees at all times and that they may limit the number of County Card rounds available on specific days.
